


# Annual Health & Performance Review: Sheep

It is a requirement that you annually complete a review of health and performance records. This must comprise of a review of mortality records (and possible reasons for mortality); reason for treatment (taken from the medicine records) and abattoir feedback (where provided).

Below is a template that covers all of the information you must complete. You may use a different template, but a similar review must be undertaken.
