



MAKE AND COLOUR IN YOUR OWN RED TRACTOR FLAG

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

1. White paper
2. Crayons, felt tips or coloured pencils
3. Scissors
4. Wooden rod - can be purchase at a DIY centre
5. Clear sticky back plastic

WHAT TO DO

1. Download and print the PDF onto plain white paper.
2. Colour in the big Red Tractor flag below.
3. Cut out the flag along the dotted line.
4. Using the wooden rod, attach the short edge to the wooden rod using sticky back plastic.

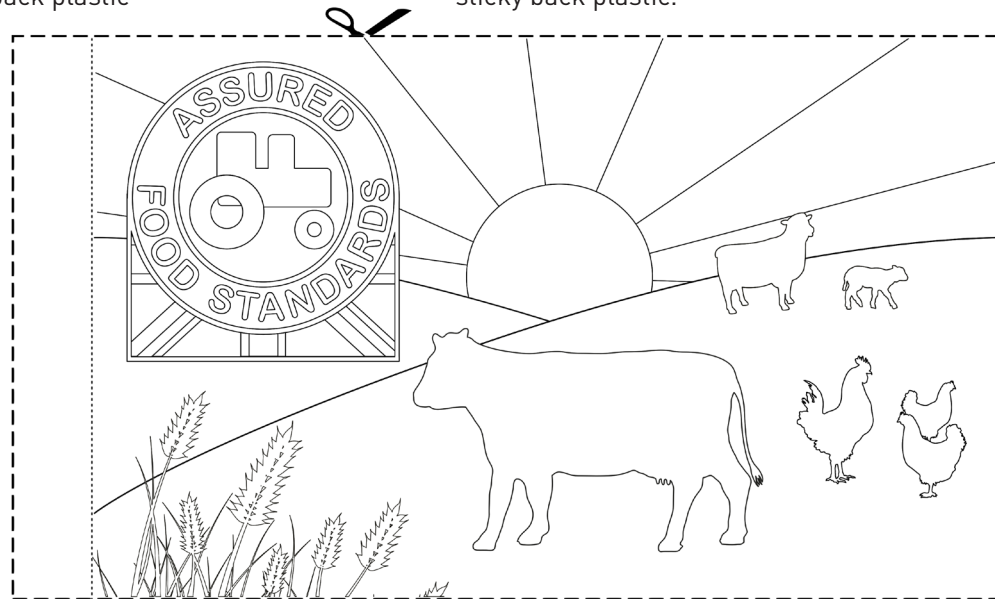

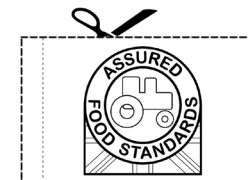

2. Colour in the small Red Tractor flag on the right.
3. Cut the flag out.
4. Using a cocktail stick, attach the short edge to the stick using sticky back plastic.
